Public Comment - Confessions of the River Parishes Tourist Commission

Confessions of the River Parishes Tourist Commission.

We are of sound mind and able to read, comprehend. If we need clarity we follow the constitution or bylaws are weak and our statue is poorly written. Slavery was legal in Louisiana and provided for by statue.

Confession #1.

Last night 8/19 the SJP council took up a resolution to reappoint Mr. Paul Aucoin to the EDC, a prerequisite to serving on our tourist commission, that member now has to be re-appointed to the tourist commission and ratified by the council, and take an oath of office, before taking any actions on the tourist commission. The exact same process is required by the home rule charter for Commissioner Camalla Landry.

From the SJP home rule charter, regarding the EDC, (a) The board shall be composed of 18 members. Each parish councilmember shall nominate two members of the board, and the parish president shall nominate four members of the board. All nominations for membership on the board shall be approved by resolution of the council passed by a majority vote.(b) The terms of all members of the board shall be concurrent with that of the members of the council.

Confession #2.

According to the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, Article VI, Local Government, Part II, "The legislature, by general or by local or special law, may authorize the imposition of additional sales and use taxes by local governmental subdivisions or school boards, if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon in an election held for that purpose."

I repeat, <u>if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon in an election held for that purpose.</u> No exceptions or reasons for exemption have been provided by the legislature, so we must uphold the <u>constitution</u>.
